EDP/Career Exploration Project

Aligns to: College and Career Readiness/Common Core State Standards

The overall goal for the project is:

• Students will develop, through listening, writing and reading activities, an awareness of the habits, experiences and choices that shape career paths.

Learner Outcomes:

• Students will apply grade level literacy and problem solving/analysis skills within the course activities in order to develop their thoughts and present their findings in written and spoken tasks.

The course includes:

- Pre writing strategies for argument and compare/contrast writing.
- Close reading of informational text and argument.
- Viewing and responding to video presentations.
- A task requiring synthesis of information from multiple sources into a supported claim.

Learning that works for Michigan

Started EDP/Performance Task Project with TBAISD—Aug. 2013

- Lots of planning and course development took place via Moodle
- Two 8th Grade Teachers with appox. 60 students from TCAPS-West volunteered to add this course to their LA (Language Arts) course. First course developed via Moodle was for 16 weeks -Jan-May, 2014
- Students' input was great! Student focus groups were formed, presented a power-point presentation in front of their peers and officials. Likes and Dislikes were shared. Students viewed the project as being very valuable and made a lot of suggestions on how to improve it for students.
- Debrief Cut down the time frame, student input, changes were made, and as a result, a two week course was launched as Pilot 2 - Nov-Dec. 2014.
 <u>Three</u> 8th grade teachers, and over 400 students were exposed to the career exploration content from the course developed in Moodle.

COURSE OVERVIEW



- The students are required to:
 - Access the Learning Management System "Moodle"
 - Access Career Cruising to set up an EDP Account
 - Complete the following sections of the EDP: Career Matchmaker, My Skills, Learning Styles, My Career Plans and Activities, My Goals, My Education Plan, My Activities & Experiences such as Extracurricular Activities, Hobbies and Interests, Skills and Abilities, Awards and Certificates, Volunteer Experience and any work experience at this point.
 - Access free online personality assessments to determine their personality type (Helper, Doer, Thinker, or Planner) colorcode.com
 - Research Careers suited for their personality types
 - Research Online Career Exploration website myplan.com with video reviews
 - Complete Performance Task to help develop their critical thinking skills
 - Read about 7 values expected in the World of Work: Attitude, Attendance, Appearance, Accountability, Acceptance, Ambition, and
 - Create Word Clouds using Wordle.net
 - Create a speaking avatar to summarize learning experiences text to speech via Voki.com
 - Create a power point presentation via Google Slides with a partner

COMMENTS FROM THE SECOND PILOT – DEC. 2014 Three Eighth Grade Teachers Volunteered:

- Over 400 students received an opportunity to find out a little about themselves and to think about a possible career.
- All three teachers would like this content presented to the 8th graders during spring around career week. For the month of March starting in 2016 as our career exploration month to include: the Annual Career Day, the High School Counselor's visit, the visit to TBAISD CTC, and to include the EDP/Career Exploration/Performance Task two week course content. If this concept is approved, planning for March 2016 would need to take place very soon so that dates are confirmed; Career Day – 2016 date, TBA; HS Visits- 2016 date, TBA; CTC Visit – 2016 TBA and the roll-out of the EDP Career Exploration/Performance Task Course would be presented at the beginning of March 2016.
